Letter to the fans of the Seven Deadly Sins series:

Thank you everyone for your support for the Seven Deadly Sins series. I appreciate all the letters and emails enthusiastic about the current books and the future MORTAL SIN.

Here's the scoop: Random House in the US opted not to publish the rest of the Seven Deadly Sins series, which unfortunately affected Random House in Australia's publication of the series. The books did amazingly well in Australia (a special thank you to my fans down under!) I am very disappointed at their decision because I love this series, but publishing is a business very concerned about the bottom line in this economy and the Deadly Sins series didn't perform quite as well as my romantic thrillers. So while I'm disappointed, I also understand.

HOWEVER, I am still looking at ALL possible options to finish this series, and am looking for the time to finish writing MORTAL SIN. It was always my intent to publish all seven books in this series. Because I don't plot out my stories before hand, I am very eager to find out what happens to Moira, Rafe, Skye, Anthony, Rico, Fiona, Selena and the other characters. I have a very vague idea of the events that will unfold, but truly, anything can happen.

I wish I had everything settled before having to write this letter, but unfortunately, I don't know what 2012 and 2013 will hold for me. Know that **I have not given up on this series and have every intention of finishing it.** It's going to take me a little time to settle the future, however.

I was asked to participate in an anthology supporting breast cancer research. Because I was eager to write another story with Rafe and Moira, I decided to pen *Ghostly Justice* for the anthology ENTANGLED which will be available digitally in mid-September, 2011.

Moira and Rafe face a deadly vampiric coven who believe they found the ancient ritual for immortality by using virgin blood.

Thank you so much for your enthusiasm about my supernatural thriller series and I know you're as disappointed as I am that we have to wait. I hope to have good news soon.
